IMPORTANT NOTICE

SPRING VALLEY METROPOLITAN DISTRICT WATER SYSTEM FLUSHING, MAY 9TH THROUGH May 12TH

Spring Valley Metropolitan District No. 1 will be flushing the water system at fire hydrant locations throughout the community. This system-wide flushing process serves two very important maintenance functions:

- 1. The process disrupts, flushes, and greatly reduces the naturally occurring sediment and minerals in the water distribution system.
- 2. The process allows for operation and preventive maintenance of the valves and fire hydrants critical to operation of the fire protection infrastructure.

Please note that while flushing operations are active **the water** is **safe to drink**, however temporary discoloration will occur due to the disruption of naturally occurring sediment and minerals.


To reduce discoloration, allow your water to run for a few minutes, ideally from your bathtub faucet. Also, we recommend that you avoid doing laundry while active flushing operations are in process.

The anticipated schedule and areas to be flushed are on the back of this notice. We will post signs at neighborhood entrances confirming the dates as we work through the process.


