NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of Spring Valley Metropolitan District No. 5 (the “**District**”), Elbert County, Colorado (the “**Board**”), will meet in special session on Friday, February 28, 2025, at the hour of 3:00 p.m., in the Small Study Room of the Elizabeth Library, 651 Beverly Street, Elizabeth, Colorado. At this meeting, it is anticipated that the Board will make a final determination to issue or refund general obligation indebtedness. Specifically, the Board intends to consider adoption of a Resolution authorizing the issuance of the District’s General Obligation Limited Tax Bonds, Series 2025A (the “**Series 2025A Bonds**”), in a maximum aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$18,300,000, which such principal amount is subject to increase or decrease as determined by the Board, for the purposes of paying or reimbursing the costs of certain public improvements for the District and paying the costs of issuance of the Series 2025A Bonds.

Also at this meeting, the Board also expects to authorize the execution of all related documents, instruments and certificates in connection therewith, ratify prior actions, authorize incidental actions, repeal prior inconsistent actions, and take up such other business as may come before the Board. The meeting is open to the public.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Supplemental Public Securities Act, one or more members of the Board may participate in this meeting and may vote on the foregoing matters through the use of a conference telephone or other telecommunications device; and no legal or equitable action brought with respect to any legislative acts or proceedings in connection with the authorization or issuance of such obligations may be commenced more than thirty days after the authorization of such obligations pursuant to the aforementioned resolution.
